DECLARATION OF INTENT BETWEEN THE JAPAN TRANSPORT SAFETY BOARD

(JTSB)

AND

THE AIR ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION BUREAU OF MONGOLIA (AAIB of Mongolia)

ON

COOPERATION RELATING TO AIRCRAFT ACCIDENT AND INCIDENT INVESTIGATION

JTSB and AAIB of Mongolia declare their intent to promote cooperation as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration of Intent (DoI) is to assist in enhancing national, regional and international aviation safety in our respective countries.

The JTSB and the AAIB of Mongolia (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Both Sides" and individually as "Side") are each committed to conducting professional accident and incident investigations that do not seek to apportion blame or liability. Both Sides also commit to publishing investigation reports highlighting any necessary safety action and recommendations to improve future safety. In commencing the cooperation under this DoI, the sole objective of Both Sides is the enhancement of aviation safety.

2. Conformity with Annex 13 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation (the Chicago Convention)

Both Sides cooperate in the accident and serious incident investigation and sharing of information/know-how in conformity with the Standards and Recommended Practices of Annex 13 to the Chicago Convention to which each country is a signatory.

3. Cooperation on aviation safety matters

In addition to Annex 13 requirements, Both Sides will seek to cooperate in aviation investigations, safety information transfer and training, and to discuss relevant management issues as resources permit for the mutual benefit of each country.

4. Confidentiality

Each Side that receives materials from the other Side should handle the materials according to their confidentiality or proprietary status, within the bound of the respective laws of the two countries. Drafts, internal or working documents that have been transmitted, except when explicitly indicated to the contrary, are to be considered as proprietary/confidential documents and treated as such.

5. Funding

Any funding required for the implementation of the cooperation under this DoI will be the responsibility of the individual Side unless otherwise arranged.
